REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITORS TO THE MEMBERS OF IGI PENSION FUND MANAGERS LIMITED.

Report on the Financial Statements

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of IGI Pension Fund Managers Limited. The financial statements comprise the statement of financial position as at 31 December 2015, the statement of comprehensive income, statement of changes in equity and statement of cash flows for the year then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

Directors' responsibility for the financial statements

The directors are responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with International Financial Reporting Standards and with the requirements of the Companies and Allied Matters Act. CAP C20 LFN 2004 and in compliance with the Financial Report Council of Nigeria Act No 6. 2011 and for such internal controls as the directors determine necessary to enable the preparation of financial statements that are free from material misstatements whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors' responsibility

Our responsibility is to express an independent opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with International Standards on Auditing. Those standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform our audit to obtain reasonable assurance that the financial statements are free from material misstatements.
